The second annual meeting of TOP NANO 21 will take place in the Kursaal (Assembly Rooms) in Bern on October 16, 2001. As was the case last year, the focus in the morning will be on general developments in the field of nanotechnology (papers will be presented by members of the TOP NANO 21 international expert group) and in the industries involved in TOP NANO 21. In the afternoon a poster session will provide an opportunity to learn detailed information about the current projects. Presentations by researchers from the Swiss research centres will provide the conclusion for the annual meeting.

Finally, the NANO Workshop for PhD Students, which takes place from October 17 to 19, in Twannberg (formerly the "Hasliberg Meeting") gives young scientists an opportunity of learning from experienced specialists about the basic principles and current developments in the field of nanotechnology.
